JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No.26, dated 06.05.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3).

2. In compliance of order dated October 29, 2015, report of Id. Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise is genuine, voluntary and is without undue influence, coercion or threat. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.26, dated 06.05.2014, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
