JASPAL SINGH, J (Oral)

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure preferred by Pargat Singh seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondent No. 2 to protect his life and liberty, at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 9.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

3. At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

4. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner has filed a complaint against respondents No. 4 to 9 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 408 IPC with the aid of Section 34 IPC, in which, they have been summoned to face trial. Now, respondents No. 4 to 9 are bent upon to compel the petitioner to withdraw the said

complaint, otherwise, he will be done to death. Though, a representation dated January 18, 2016 (Annexure P-1) in this regard was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda but till date no action has been taken.

5. The present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found therein, to take appropriate action, in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
