Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.86, dated 25.07.2016, under Sections 15/16/61/85 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 21.10.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail on furnishing of bail bonds amounting to Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not needed by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 21.10.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
