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This order be read in this case as well as in CWP No. 14279 of 2001.

At the instance of Sukhbir-workman the Industrial Tribunal-cum-Labour Court had given a award dated 1.6.2001. The award was that the petitioner is entitled to be reinstated with continuity etc. but without back wages. Two writ petitions were filed against that award; one by the workman bearing CWP No. 14279 of 2001 claiming full back wages whereas CWP No. 5349 of 2002 was filed by the Management challenging the award itself so far as reinstatement was ordered.

We find from the record with the help of learned counsel for the respondent that there is no stay granted by the Bench regarding implementation of the award. We can take it that the award must have been implemented regarding reinstatement by now. Consequently, CWP No. 5349 of 2002 has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

CWP No. 14279 of 2001

So far as CWP No. 14279 of 2001 is concerned, learned counsel

for the petitioner has stated that instead of full back wages if the respondents agree to pay 50% of the back wages, he would withdraw the writ petition.

Learned AAG Punjab prays for time to get instructions in the matter.

CWP No. 14279 of 2001 is adjourned to 22.10.2016.
