Instant petition has been preferred under Section 439 Cr.P.C., by petitioner-Shubham seeking grant of bail during pendency of trial, in case FIR No.76 dated 03.03.2016, under Sections 147, 148, 149, 323 and 307 IPC, Police Station Sector 31, Chandigarh.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has emerged that a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has already been filed by the petitioner on the basis of compromise for quashing of above noted FIR, which is listed for 05.12.2016 in this Court.

3. Since, the parties have already effected a compromise and have sought quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, it would not be desirable to keep the petitioner behind the bars for an indefinite period.

4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is allowed

and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail at the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
