The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of Rapat No.18 dated 30.8.2011 in FIR No.284 dated 28.8.2011 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on)registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City (Annexure P1) along with all the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 23.9.2013 (Annexure P3).

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Amritsar received that statements of the parties have been recorded and that the parties have entered into compromise. Puran Singh injured has

stated that he has effected the compromise with all the accused and he has no objection if the FIR in question is quashed.

Since the injured has stated that he has effected the compromise with all the accused, therefore, Rapat No.18 dated 30.8.2011 in FIR No.284 dated 28.8.2011 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 326 IPC (added later on) registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City (Annexure P1) along with all the consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition stands allowed.
