The petition is filed by Tarsem Singh, Banta Singh and Manjit Kaur praying for quashing FIR No.123 dated 21.11.2012, registered under Section 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur and the consequent proceedings arisen therefrom.

The matrimonial dispute which has culminated in FAO No.62 of 2015 was referred before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre for an amicable settlement of the matrimonial dispute between the parties. Both the parties have amicably settled their dispute. The complainant, Jasveer Kaur, has undertaken to withdraw the above complaint given by her to facilitate the settlement of their matrimonial dispute. Today, FAO No.62 of 2015 was taken up for hearing in second motion. The complainant has undertaken to withdraw the complaint given by her under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC. The matrimonial dispute has now been completely settled by the parties and they have suffered statements in the shape of affidavits in the first motion and

second motion as well. A decree of divorce by mutual consent has also been granted by this Court today.

As the parties have amicably settled their matrimonial dispute and the complainant party has undertaken to withdraw the present complaint which culminated in registration of the case under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC, invoking the jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C., FIR No.123 dated 21.11.2012, registered under Section 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Kulgari, District Ferozepur and all consequential proceedings arisen therefrom stand quashed.

The petition is ordered accordingly.
