FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 18.11.2015 sent by learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Kuldip Singh @ Laddi, Swambarjit Singh @ Pinka and Gurwinder Singh @ Vicky Kanda as well as of complainant Thakur Kulrattan Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a non-injury case and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.128 dated 23.10.2013 under

Sections 364, 384, 307, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 and 27 of Arms Act Police Station, B-Division, Amritsar City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
