The petitioners seek grant of regular bail in case FIR No.102, dated 9.6.2013, registered under Sections 365/34, 302, 201, 380 of the IPC, at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioners states that similarly situated co-accused, Harjinder Singh @ Herry, had filed CRM-M No.7248 of 2016 for grant of regular bail and this Court, vide order dated 1.8.2016

(Annexure P-5) had dismissed the petition and it was directed that in

view of the undertaking given by the counsel for the respondent, in case the prosecution did not lead its entire evidence on or before 30.9.2016 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same), the petitioner therein be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners in the present case have also been in custody since 11.6.2013.

Counsel for the respondent has accepted these factual assertions and has not been able to show how the case of the petitioners is different to that of the co-accused.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioners. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. Petition stands disposed of.
