Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in a case arising out of FIR No.35 dated 26.09.2015, registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Bathinda, who have been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from the investigating officer, has informed that they have received the bills of 10 tolas of gold and five tolas that were given out of the family estimates. He further submits that 6½ tolas of gold has been recovered. He also states that in compliance of the order dated 26.10.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. At this stage, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required.

In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the

case, order dated 26.10.2015 passed by this Court whereby the ad-interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioners is made absolute, subject to deposit of ₹4 lacs as security with the trial Court. The petitioners shall continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
