By virtue of the instant petitioner preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought direction to the official respondents to conduct inquiry into the allegations levelled with the complaint with regard to high handedness of the police authorities including respondent Nos.7 to 18 against the petitioner in FIR No.312, dated November 12, 2011, under Sections 379, 364, 302, 120B and 201 IPC, registered at Police Station Tarori, District Karnal.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. P.S. Paul, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated September 08, 2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved, but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

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At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.4-Inspector General of Police, Karnal Range, District Karnal to decide his representation dated September 08, 2016 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.4-Inspector General of Police, Karnal Range, District Karnal to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated September 08, 2016 (Annexure P-2) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
