Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.128 dated 10.8.2015, registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Bathinda, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant/respondent No.2 as well as the accused and has reported that the parties have effected compromise which is not the result of any pressure or coercion in any manner and the same is valid.

Since the parties have compromised, therefore, FIR No.128 dated 10.8.2015, registered under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, District Bathinda, along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
