Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, who has been booked for having committed the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 200, 181, 171 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, in a case arising out of FIR No.806 dated 14.09.2015, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Hissar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the plots were allotted to the petitioner on different dates and there was no concealment on his part. He further contends that it was for the HUDA Authorities to verify whether the petitioner was entitled to allotment of subsequent plots or not. An affidavit was filed by the petitioner as per requirement of the policy and when the factum of multiple allotment came to his notice, the last allotted plot was surrendered and the same has been cancelled. It is next submitted that the entire case is based on the documentary evidence and the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by Inspector Umed Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 17.11.2015, is made absolute.
