It is submitted that the petitioner who is the appellant in appeal bearing case No.74/01.12.12 now pending in the Court of District & Sessions Judge, Faridabad was unable to appear on the relevant date (30.08.2016) on account of his ill disposition. To support his contention, medical documents have been placed on record.

It now transpires that the matter is now returnable before the learned Appellate Court on 28.10.2016 as the warrant issued against the petitioner could not be executed. In the given circumstances and in the interest of justice, one opportunity is granted to the petitioner to mend his ways for the future. He shall surrender before the Court concerned on or before the scheduled date after which he may be granted fresh bail on such terms and conditions as may be deemed appropriate by the Court.

In the meantime, the warrant of arrest issued against him shall remain stayed. The matter is, thus, disposed of.
