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**HARI PAL VERMA J.(Oral)**

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Devender Singh, submits that the statement of father of petitioner No1, namely Partap Singh (respondent No.4) has been recorded. As per statement made by Partap Singh (respondent No.4), he has disowned petitioner No.1-Mandeep Kaur and stated therein that he has not caused any harm or threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. The photocopy of the said statement of Partap Singh (respondent No.4) is taken on record.

Nobody is present on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the statement made by Partap Singh (respondent No.4), no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of. However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach SSP, Tran Taran, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
