The petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered on the basis of application filed by constable MC Radipa of BSF to the effect that on 14.9.2014, there was suspicious movement of two miscreants from Pakistan on Indo-Pak border. A special ambush was planned. Miscreants escaped throwing two packets of heroin.

So far as the petitioner is concerned, he along with co-accused Sukhdev Singh and Jugraj Singh were found with pistol and cartridges. Petitioner alongwith Mukhtiar Singh was allegedly known to Pakistani smugglers. However, it is a case where no recovery has been effected from the petitioner.

In view of above, petitioner having not been found in exclusive possession of any contraband, he can be granted the concession of bail. The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
