JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

This common order shall dispose of two aforementioned petitions seeking regular bail on behalf of two petitioners/accused, namely, Sunny and Sukhjit @ Sabi in case bearing FIR No.101 dated 29.08.2015, under Sections 365, 506, 323, 364, 470, 120-B, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and (Sections 323, 364, 470, 120-B, 148 and 149, IPC added later on), registered with Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur.

Both the petitioners and the complainant-Balbir Singh are resident of the adjoining Villages.

The allegations are that son-Sukhwinder Singh @ Kala of the complainant was picked up at night from his house and thereafter given 20 injuries on his person and was left in the fields.

It is contended that all the injuries have been opined to be simple in nature and both the petitioners are in custody since 01.09.2015. The challan is stated to have been presented after completion of the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by HC Manjeet Singh, is unable to refute the aforesaid factual situation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that trial is not likely to conclude in near future, both the petitions are allowed and the petitioners/accused, namely, Sunny and Sukhjit @ Sabi are ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
