The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.64 dated 30.06.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

Learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the report of the Chemical Examiner has since been received and the salt of Diacetylmorphine had been found in the sample that had been sent.

The alleged recovery was of 260 grams.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition.

Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to observe that the interim protection granted to the petitioner as regards arrest vide order dated 07.12.2015 would cease to operate.
