The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.757, dated 4.9.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar.

Allegations against the petitioner are that he was employed with the complainant. There is a dispute whether his services were terminated or whether he resigned. However, after his services came to

an end, there was apparently bad blood between them and the petitioner had also lodged several false cases against the management, and for the purpose of bolstering one of such cases, he has forged an order of the National Human Rights Commission.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has now been in custody for more three months.

Learned Addl. AG Haryana as well as counsel for the complainant have accepted this factual assertion. Counsel for the complainant has, however, argued that propensity of the petitioner is such that as soon as he is released, he will launch more cases against the management without any regard whether they are true or not.

Be that as it may, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
