Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the eight petitioners, namely, Gurpreet Singh, Harjit Singh, Jagjit Singh, Kuljit Singh, Malkiat Singh, Harvinder Kaur @ Harjinder Kaur, Kashmir Kaur and Ajit Singh in case FIR No.109 dated 31.07.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 447, 380, 506, 427, 148 & 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Gharinda, Police, District Amritsar Rural, Punjab.

The allegations against the accused party is that they have committed theft of various articles lying in the room situated in the filed of the complainant apart from damaging the standing crop.

It was contended that the dispute is between co-sharers and the two main accused Kashmir Singh and Sukhwinder Singh stood arrested and the recovery of the stolen articles have been effected. It is next contended that the present petitioners have since joined investigation and cooperated in the same.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Jaspal Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 06th of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
