HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking transfer of investigation in case FIR No.364 dated 10.6.2016 under Section 304-A IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal to some independent agency or Vigilance Department outside the Palwal district.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in spite of overwhelming evidence against the accused, investigation is not being conducted by the police. The petitioner has also made repeated representations to the authorities, but no action has been taken on said representations.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

Admittedly, the FIR in question was registered on 10.6.2016. In

case prayer of the petitioner is accepted at this stage, it would lead to interference in the investigation. Even otherwise, no such material has been placed on record by the petitioner which may warrant transfer of investigation in the case. Therefore, this Court does not find any merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
