The petitioners have approached this Court for directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8.

As per Annexure P-1, Aadhaar Card, the age of petitioner No.1 Baljeet Kaur is more than 26 years, her date of birth being 15.7.1990 but petitioner No.2 Gurpreet Singh has not so far attained the age of marriage, he being 19 years of age as per Annexure P-2, Aadhaar Card.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the allegations made, the instant petition is disposed of with the

direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda that in case the petitioners move an application before him seeking protection for their life, he will look into the same.
