INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.90 dated 10.09.2016, registered at Police Station GRP, Bathinda, under Sections 401 and 411 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Shivali, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, on the basis of secret information that the present petitioner along with others while armed with deadly weapons, are planning to commit dacoity at night, a raid was conducted. The present petitioner was apprehended at the spot

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and an iron rod was recovered from him.

The petitioner has been in custody since 10.09.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
