Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No.279 dated 21.08.2016, registered at Police Station Beri District Jhajjar, Haryana, under Section 18 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the recovery effected from the petitioner is 700 grams opium which falls in non-commercial quantity. He has further argued that no other case is pending against the petitioner and he has been in custody for two months.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has accepted these factual assertions.

Keeping in view the period of custody suffered by the petitioner and the fact that the recovery is non-commercial, I do not deem it

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appropriate to deny the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of learned trial
Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
