JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)

This common order shall dispose of both the aforementioned petitions seeking anticipatory bail on behalf of petitioner/accused-Swaran Singh and his three other co-accused son, namely, Sarabjit Singh, Kuljit Singh and Tarsem Singh in case bearing FIR No.171 dated 03.10.2015, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 61/1/14 of the Punjab Excise Act, registered with Police Station Kambo, District Amritsar.

Learned Counsel for the parties heard at length.

It has come on the file that all the four petitioners are residing in the same house and are involved in distilling and selling of illicit liquor.

A recovery of 110 Cans containing total 33 lacs milliliters of illicit liquor has been made from the house of the petitioners.

It is also stated that all the petitioners are involved in number of other cases including the cases of under the Excise Act.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence of the petitioners being habitual offenders, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, both the aforesaid petitions are dismissed.
