The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.143, dated 1.10.2015, registered under Sections 406/420 of the IPC, at Police Station Passiana, District Patiala.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has

repeatedly joined the investigation and is not required for custodial investigation.

Learned Additional Advocate General Punjab, on instructions from ASI Parwinder Singh, has accepted the aforementioned fact but states that the petitioner has to make payment of ₹ 5 lacs to the complainant, which fact is disputed by counsel for the petitioner.

In the circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Consequently, the order dated 17.11.2015 is made absolute, subject to the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
