1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?

Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral)

This is a petition for quashing of FIR No.131 dated 09.12.2010, under Sections 120-B and 420, IPC, registered at Police Station, Longowal, District Sangrur, Punjab and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned Addl.Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sangrur received. The learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of both the parties and has reported that parties have effected the compromise without any pressure and coercion. Photocopies of the statements have also been appended with the report.

It was a money dispute between the parties. Since the matter has been settled, therefore, present petition is allowed and FIR No.131 dated 09.12.2010, under Sections 120-B and 420, IPC, registered at Police Station, Longowal, District Sangrur, Punjab and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, stand quashed.
