Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C is for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 151 dated 27.5.2016 under Sections 302/323/34 IPC and 25/54/59 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that petitioner has been involved only on the basis of disclosure statement made by the petitioner and his co-accused namely Rohtash.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Dalbir Singh, ASI states that the petitioner along with Rohtash was present at the time of occurrence and when the complainant asked from Rohtash for the purpose of calling his brother Ravinder, then Rohtash fired a pistol shot on the chest of his brother Ravinder due to which Ravinder fell down and when he tried to catch Rohtash and petitioner-Sunil@ Dholu, then petitioner gave an iron

pipe blow on the left side of head of the complainant as a result of which he fell down and when he raised noise then Rohtash and petitioner-Sunil@Dholu fled away.

Since there are specific allegations against the petitioner, no case for grant of bail is made out.

The Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is accordingly dismissed.
