Instant petition has been filed for issuing directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to complete the investigation and file the challan in FIR No. 170 dated 08.10.2015, registered under Section 376 IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

On notice, reply has been filed by Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Adampur, on 16.02.2016 stating that after registration of the FIR, the enquiry was marked to Nirlep Singh Athwal then to Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Adampur, wherein in his report dated 03.12.2015 he held that petitioner has some civil dispute with Kashmiri Lal, her brother-in-law with respect to share of house in which they were living with their families and on account of nursing a grudge FIR was got registered by the petitioner. In the enquiry report (Annexure R-1/T) given by the DSP, he recommended cancellation of FIR and this was approved by the SSP, Jalandhar.

It has been informed by the learned State counsel, on instructions, from ASI Sukhdev Raj, that enquiry report Annexure R-1/T was approved.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to file the cancellation report, before the appropriate Court within a period of one month.
