This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.202 dated 11.10.2015, under Sections 323/452/427/34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Rupnagar, District Rupnagar.

Allegations in the FIR are with regard to the present petitioners having caused injuries to the complainant, Dharampal.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Inder Pal would concede that in pursuance to the order dated 31.10.2015 passed by this Court, the petitioners have since joined investigation. It is also conceded that there is no MLR conducted in respect of the complainant, Dharampal which would reflect any injury that may have been suffered by him.

Under such circumstances and keeping in view that the petitioners have already joined investigation, petition is allowed. Order dated 31.10.2015 is made absolute.
