Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.138 dated 24.05.2014, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar, Mohali, under Sections 22/61/85 of N.D.P.S. Act.

Learned State counsel after seeking instructions from the investigating officer present in Court states that five prosecution witness have already been examined and now case is fixed for 12.01.2016 for prosecution evidence.

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Being faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition, however, prays that trial Court may be directed to conclude the trial at the earliest.

Dismissed being not pressed.

However, trial Court is directed to conclude the trial and decide the case on merit within a stipulated period preferably within six months from today.
