Petitioner is alleged to have sexually assaulted a minor,
Warisa on 08.09.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner
has been falsely implicated in the case as the petitioner had been beaten
on that particular day regarding which he had submitted a
representation.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner, counsel for
the complainant as well as learned State counsel and gone through the
record.

Taking into consideration the nature of allegation against
the petitioner, no extraordinary exceptional circumstances exist to grant

the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

The petition is dismissed. However, nothing said in this order will prejudice the right of the petitioner to seek regular bail by surrendering before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 15 days. In case, the petitioner surrenders before the Illaqa Magistrate within a period of 15 days, his application for bail will be decided within a period of 2/3 days.
