TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA. J (ORAL)

Petitioners seek concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.61 dated 17.07.2015, under Sections 425/341/323/148/149 of Indian Penal Code and Section 325 of IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

On 27.11.2015, the following order was passed by this Court:

“During the course of arguments, it has been revealed by learned counsel for the parties that while lodging the first information report, the petitioners were not named by the informant.

In view of the above, before final adjudication of the present petition, it is directed that the petitioners would appear before the Investigating Officer on 04.12.2015 at 10.00 a.m. And continue to join the investigation as and when required to do so and also

abide by all the conditions laid down under Section 438 (2), Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 28.01.2016.

In the meantime, in the event of their arrest, the petitioners shall be released on ad-interim bail, subject to their furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty-five thousand only) with one surety in the like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Krishan Singh, Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur would apprise the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation on 04.12.2015.

Counsel for the State as also counsel appearing for the informant have not been able to rebut the fact that the present petitioners were not even named in the first instance by the informant.

In view of the above, custodial interrogation of the petitioners would not be warranted.

Order dated 27.11.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
