This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.12 dated 16.01.2014, under Sections 406/420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station, Tripuri Town, Tehsil and District Patiala.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 02.11.2015:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that since the petitioner was out of station at Puna on account of his job, he was not informed about the date fixed before the trial Court and, therefore, could not appear.

Notice of motion for 25.01.2016.

Meanwhile, if the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, the trial Court shall admit him on bail subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.”

It has gone uncontroverted that the petitioner had duly surrendered before the trial Court on 06.11.2015 and was admitted to bail subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner has also made a statement that the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre at Patiala and settlement has arrived at between the parties.

Under such circumstances, the present petition is allowed. Order dated 02.11.2015, passed by this Court, is made absolute.

It is made clear that in case the present petitioner does not adhere to the settlement that has been arrived at and as indicated by the counsel for the petitioner, it would be open for the complainant to seek cancellation of concession granted.

Petition disposed of.
