The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.32, dated 10.3.2016, registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the IPC, at Police Station Haibowal, Ludhiana.

As per allegations and the investigation, the petitioner sold some land to the complainant which was actually non-existent.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the sale took place

in 2012. In 2014, the complainant executed a general power of attorney

in favour of a third person and the FIR has been lodged after a further period of two years i.e in 2016 and the petitioner has been in custody for six months. It is a case of Magisterial trial.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Baldev Raj, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
