The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.106 dated 12.08.2011 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, in view of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent/complainant submits that compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 22.09.2016 asking for recording of statement of the parties in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court through the District and Sessions Judge,

Hoshiarpur. I have perused the same. In my opinion, the quashment of FIR by way of compromise/compounding in view of statements recorded, deserves to be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-37203 OF 2015 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.106 dated 12.08.2011 registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 148 & 149 IPC at Police Station Bullowal, District Hoshiarpur, is quashed by way of compromise/compounding qua the petitioners only along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
