Pursuant to a dispute, regarding Panchayat election, the complainant, namely Rajinder, was assaulted by the petitioner and five-six other persons on 05.08.2016, armed with iron rods, *binda*, etc. So far as the petitioner is concerned, he has not been attributed any specific injury, though there are thirteen injuries, including six fractures on the person of Devinder Singh.

The challan having already been presented and three co-accused of the petitioner having been granted the concession of bail, the petitioner can be released on bail, he being in custody

since 09.08.2016.

The petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the conditions that the petitioner will not indulge in any similar activity and will not directly or indirectly induce or pressurize any of the witnesses acquainted with the facts of the case.

In case of the petitioner committing the similar offence, the bail granted to him would be liable to be cancelled.
