JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 400, dated 09.09.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Safidon, District Jind.

The complainant is an Advocate and as per his allegations, vide Agreement of full payment, he has been sold a plot by non-applicant/co-accused-Rajender Singh vide written document dated 28.02.2014, reinforced by another document executed by Jitender, non-applicant/co-accused, on 29.04.2015 between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner does not figure in the aforesaid FIR nor his client has anything to do with the said land.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Ramesh Kumar and counsel for the complainant submit that during the investigation, it has surfaced that the petitioner-Radhey Krishan @ Radha Kishan had forged the signatures of the original owner-Sita Ram regarding the plot in dispute, while forging the Agreement of full payment executed on 15.03.2013 in favour of Rajender Singh. It is further conceded that although challan has been filed, however, there is no report from the handwriting expert regarding alleged forged signatures of the petitioner on the Agreement of full payment dated 15.03.2013.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the facts noticed above and the challan has already been presented, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner/accused in custody, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Disposed of.
