Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents not to exercise unauthorised intrusion, compel to attend the police station or pressurising to state things as well as for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not staying with her husband since the year 2003. He has, rather, been disowned by her father-in-law, namely, Ram Sawrup. However, the police is unnecessarily calling the petitioner despite the fact that she is not staying with her husband. He further states that highlighting the aforesaid facts, the petitioner has already made a complaint/representation dated 4.4.2016 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent of Police, Hisar and the petitioner

would be satisfied if the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Hisar is directed to look into the contents of said complaint/representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Hisar to look into the contents of complaint/representation dated 4.4.2016 (Annexure P-3) and to take appropriate action in accordance with law. It is made clear that in case the petitioner is involved in any case, the police would not be secluded to initiate action against the petitioner.
