This order will dispose of two criminal petitions bearing CRM Nos.M-37278 of 2015 and 2457 of 2016, being the version and cross version.

Both the petitions have been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (in short 'Cr.P.C.') for quashing of FIR No.183 dated 09.07.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 452, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (in short 'IPC') and

Section 326 IPC (added later on) on the statement of respondent

No.2 registered at Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, and cross case DDR No.31, dated 09.07.2015, under Sections 323, 324 read with Section 34 IPC along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Report of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala received that he has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused in both the cross cases and has reported that the compromise has been effected between the parties and the same is genuine and without any pressure.

In view of the compromise effected between the parties, FIR in question as well as DDR in question along with all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom stand quashed.

Both the petitions are allowed, accordingly.
