Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.201 dated 16.11.2008, under Sections 452, 324, 427, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Line, Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 3.11.2014 the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court to get their statements recorded in support of the compromise and the trial Court was

directed to forward a detailed report in that regard to this Court.

The report from the trial Court has been received vide communication dated 2.12.2014 as sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala that no compromise has been effected between the injured Baljit Singh and accused persons.

Perusal of previous orders shows that none had put in appearance on behalf of petitioners on 12.12.2014, 10.4.2015, 6.8.2015, 7.12.2015 and 29.2.2016. Even today nobody is present to represent the petitioners. It seems that the petitioners have no interest to pursue the present petition.

In view of the report dated 2.12.2014 received from the learned Magistrate coupled with the fact that nobody is representing the petitioners from the last so many dates, the present petition, which is based on compromise, no more survive, and same is accordingly dismissed.

However, petitioners are at liberty to file fresh petition, in the event of any compromise entered between the parties.
