Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the allegations made, the instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur that in case the petitioner moves an application before him seeking protection for her life and liberty, he will look into the matter and provide necessary protection to her, if he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioner is in danger at the hands of respondent No. 5 & 6.
