Perused case diary. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner is alleged to have taken huge amount of money from the complainant on the false promise of marrying him, and to have subsequently retracted from her promise.

It however transpires that the first marriage of the complainant still subsists.

In the circumstances, all promises allegedly made by the petitioner would ex-facie appear to be void. Consequently, payment of the money, if left outstanding would indicate only the pending discharge of any civil liabilities.

For the aforesaid reasons, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail after her surrendering before the Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate concerned within a fortnight subject to imposition of appropriate terms and conditions.

The present petition stands disposed of.
