Quashing of FIR No.32 dated 30.04.2015, under Sections 363/366-A IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1), is sought on the basis of affidavit dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-4) given by Paramjit Kaur-respondent No.3.

The petitioner had solemnized marriage with Paramjit Kaur-respondent No.3, who is stated to be 20 years of age as her date of birth is 19.09.1995. Complainant-Avtar Singh alias Tara (father of Paramjit Kaur) has got recorded the aforesaid FIR alleging that her daughter had been kidnapped by the petitioner.

Upon notice, learned counsel for respondent No.2-complainant has put in appearance and informed the Court that after marriage, his daughter-Paramjit Kaur is staying in her matrimonial house with Rajwinder

Singh-petitioner and he has no objection to the said marriage.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed that on 14.03.2016, offence under Section 376 IPC has been added in the FIR.

In her affidavit dated 23.10.2015 (Annexure P-4), Paramjit daughter of Avtar Singh (complainant) has specifically stated that she got married to Rajwinder Singh @ Bohar (petitioner) with her own free will and without any threat or pressure. Now, she is living with Rajwinder Singh in her matrimonial house. She does not want to take any action against the petitioner. She has no objection, if the present FIR is quashed.

Keeping in view that Paramjit Kaur (daughter of complainant) is happily residing with her husband i.e. petitioner in her matrimonial house, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.32 dated 30.04.2015, under Sections 363/366-A IPC, registered at Police Station, Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka, is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
