JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Dalip Singh and Rajinder Singh in case FIR No.267 dated 13.08.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 417, 420 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Civil Lines, District Amritsar City.

As per the allegations the petitioners had received a sum of Rs.20 lacs for inducting the complainant Surinder Singh as a partner in a gas agency.

It was contended that a partnership deed was duly executed and joint account opened, however, on account of loses, the complainant was

demanding his money back. The dispute thus being purely of civil nature, no offence was made out.

It is next contended that the petitioners have since joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 02nd of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
