This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.91 dated 22.02.2016 registered under Sections 302, 201, 34 IPC and 25 of Arms Act at Police Station-Sadar Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that in fact it is a blind murder case because originally complainant had expressed the

apprehension that the petitioner and Ranjeet had killed the deceased but

while giving the testimony had not supported the case of prosecution.

Learned DAG has accepted that there is no eye witness and the complainant has not supported prosecution version but states that the knife was recovered from co-accused Ranjeet. It is also not disputed that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 08 months.

In the circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.
