INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner, Sukhchain Singh, has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.01 dated 18.02.2015, registered at Police Station NRI, Amritsar City, District Amritsar, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that as per the allegations in FIR, the present petitioner forged power of attorney of Jasbir Singh and sold his (Jasbir Singh) property. The signatures have been got compared and these are found to be forged signatures of Jasbir Singh.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, I find that the petitioner is not entitled for the benefit of

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anticipatory bail. Otherwise also, the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
