The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.673 dated 28.09.2016 registered under Sections 3/4/7 Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956 and Section 370 IPC at Police Station Central Faridabad.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner who is a woman, said to be manager of massage center, which is alleged to have indulged into the offences under Sections 3/4/7 Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956 and Section 370 IPC. On the disclosure statement the petitioner is being prosecuted that she was conducting the affairs of the parlor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, makes statement that the petitioner will not henceforth indulge in such type of offences.

The statement of counsel for the petitioner is accepted.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on *ad-interim* anticipatory bail in FIR No.673 dated 28.09.2016 registered under Sections 3/4/7 Immoral Traffic Prevention Act, 1956 and Section 370 IPC at Police Station Central Faridabad, on furnishing of bail bonds amounting to ₹10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.
