Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439(2) for cancellation of the anticipatory bail granted to respondent Nos.2 and 3, vide order dated 22.07.2016 (Annexure P-2), passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, in case FIR No.13 dated 16.05.2016, registered under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Ferozepur.

Perusal of order dated 22.07.2016 (Annexure P-2) shows that the interim bail granted to respondent Nos.2 and 3 was made absolute by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ferozepur, keeping in view the fact that *Istridhan* articles have been recovered from them, though as per complainant, golden ornaments have not been recovered.

Such articulated order, containing valid reasons, cannot legally

be set aside in the garb of petition for cancellation of bail, unless and until

the same is totally illegal and without jurisdiction. The learned counsel did not point out any patent illegality or legal infirmity in the impugned order.

In the light of aforesaid reasons, as there is no merit, therefore, the instant petition for cancellation of bail is hereby dismissed as such.
