Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

In FIR No.54 dated 15.07.2015, registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 326, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur, the petitioners are being prosecuted.

Now the petitioners have come with a plea of compromise between the complainant who is stated to have expired after the execution of the compromise deed.

Mr. Imran Farooqi, Advocate for respondent No. 2-complainant who has appeared present before the Court. I have perused the compromise deed, the perusal of which shows that with the intervention of the respectable persons of both the parties the compromise has taken place and, therefore, the complainant does not want to pursue the case.

In that view of the matter, the FIR is quashed. The petitioners are 10 in number and at the instance of respondent No. 2 the criminal law was set

in motion. The litigation was undertaken.

In that view of the matter I think the compounding/compromise can be allowed.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:-

1. FIR No.54 dated 15.07.2015, registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 326, 148 and 149 of IPC, at Police Station Sadar Batala, District Gurdaspur, is being quashed by way of compounding/compromise along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom subject to payment of costs in the sum of ₹ 5,000/- to each petitioner (total ₹ 50,000/-) with the District Collector, Gurdaspur within a period of 06 months from today.

Disposed of.
